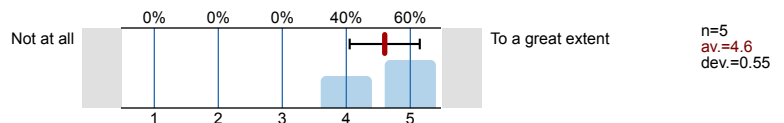

- Talking about current events at the start of class.

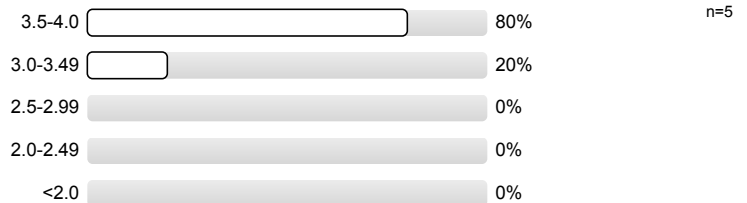
2.3) If necessary, clarify any of your previous responses or make additional comments:

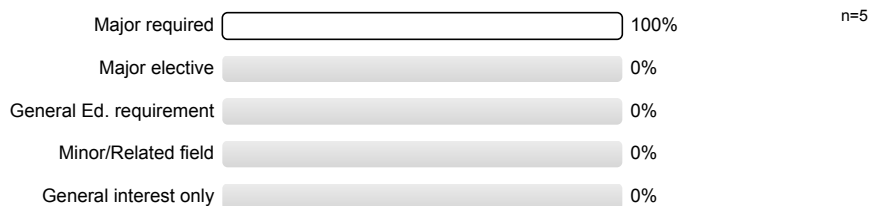

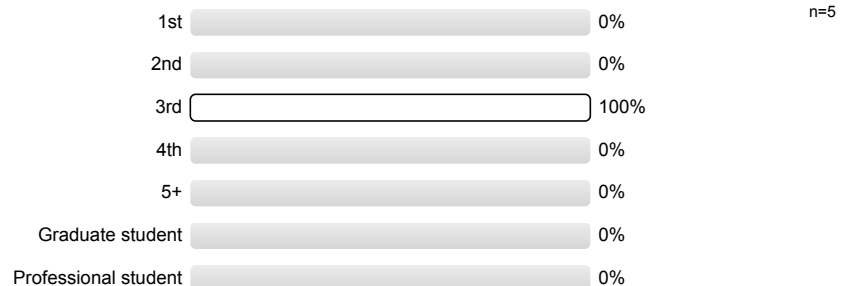
3.1) Overall GPA at UIC



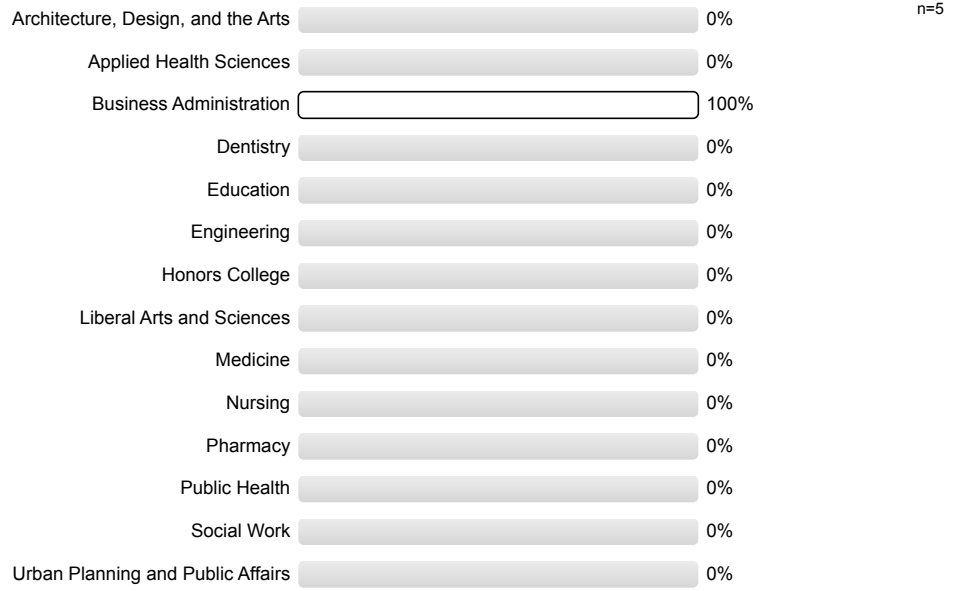
3.2) Primary Reason for taking the Course
